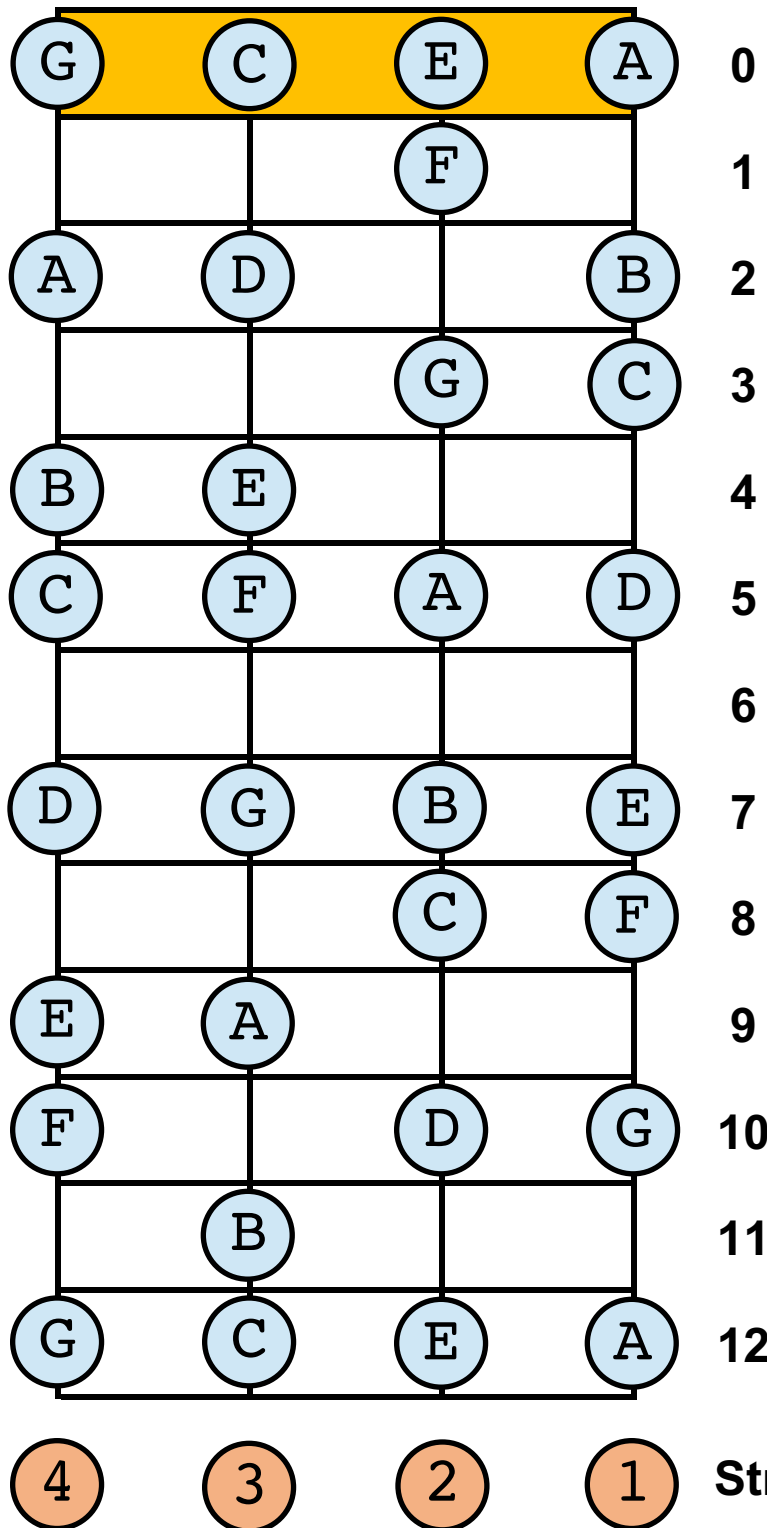


# Ukulele Fretboard



## SHARPS:

If you raise a note to the next fret, it's called a sharp.

*Find locations for A# C# D# F# and G#*

## FLATS:

If you lower a note to the next fret, it's called a flat.

*Find locations for G<sub>b</sub>, E<sub>b</sub>, D<sub>b</sub>, B<sub>b</sub>, and A<sub>b</sub>*

## Dots on Your Fretboard:

There's a pretty good chance you have dots on your fretboard, or on the side of your fretboard. They're probably on frets 5, 7, 10 and 12 to help you find your way around.
