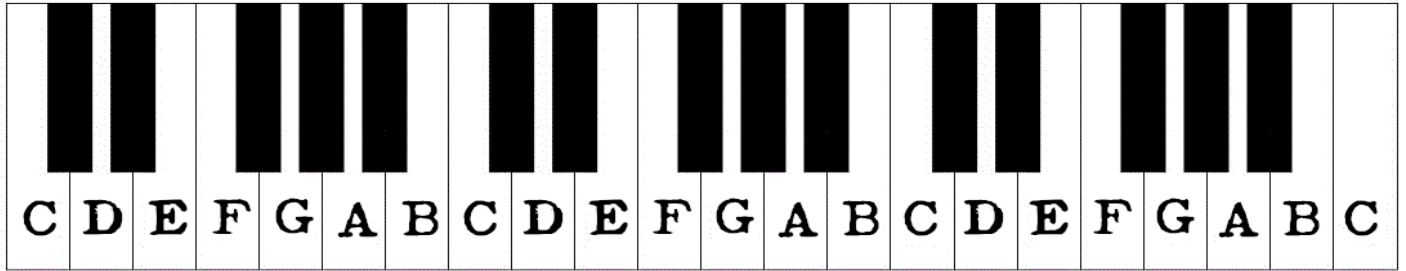

Playing Scales: All effective musician memorize the piano keyboard layout. The layout of the "white keys" are labeled. The black keys have two names (sharp or flat). For now, use only your thumb on your right hand. When you hit the high note, turn around and go back down immediately without hitting the high note twice. On your left hand use:

First Position

- If you play a 1: Use your index finger.
- If you play a 2: Use your middle finger.
- If you play a 3: Use your ring finger.
- If you play a 4: Use your pinkie finger.

Fifth Position

- If you play a 5: Use your index finger.
- If you play a 7: Use your ring finger.
- If you play a 8: Use your pinkie finger.
